# **RULES & REGULATIONS**

## **Welsh Pony & Cob Society**

The Welsh Pony and Cob Society offers Medals Section "A", "B", "C" and "D" for Stallions, Mares and Youngstock registered in the Society's Stud Book. Medals will be awarded to the Champion or Reserve Champion. Geldings are also eligible to receive a Society Medal.

1. In the case of an animal not registered at the time of entry at the Show at which a medal is competed for, application for registration must be made within one month of the date of the Show, otherwise the medal will not be awarded.
2. No animal shall be awarded more than one medal in any one year. Medals awarded at the Royal Welsh Show and those major Shows listed in the Panel of Judges which award medals are excepted from this rule (i.e. an animal can be awarded one gold, one silver and one bronze medal in any one season).
3. Medals will only be awarded to animals whose owners are members of the Welsh Pony and Cob Society and who have paid their subscriptions for the current year or are Life Members or who have submitted their names for membership and paid one annual subscription of Life membership composition. Owners who are not current members will be allowed 14 days after 1 August, 2016 to join the Society.
4. Medals will only be awarded when the classes are judged by a judge who is on the Panel of Judges of the Welsh Pony and Cob Society. (Copy available on application.)
5. Classification in the schedules of the Societies affiliated to the Welsh Pony and Cob Society should in all cases be in keeping with the Welsh Pony and Cob Society's rules in relation to height limits and weight of shoes.
  - SECTION "A"—Welsh Mountain Poinies, not exceeding 121.9cm.
  - SECTION "B"—Welsh Ponies, not exceeding 137.2cm.
  - SECTION "C"—Welsh Ponies (Cob Type), not exceeding 137.2cm
  - SECTION "D"—Welsh Cobs. No height limit.
  - "Welsh Part Bred": Minimum 12½% Registered Welsh Blood.
6. All colts and stallions, 4 years old or over, must be in possession of a Society Licence of correctness (or acknowledged alternative) to be eligible for the award of a medal.
7. Half an inch will be allowed in height for shoeing.
8. Only animals entered in the Catalogue are able to compete for the W.P. & C.S. Bronze Medal classes (no substitutions will be allowed).

Running alongside this is the National High Point Veteran of the Year. Open to all veterans nineteen years of age and over, shown in hand, with points gained throughout the year. Free competition cards are available for owners to complete from the WPCS Offices.

### **Rescue Horse or Pony**

Rescue classes to be judged on history, conformation and turnout. A short history (under 200 words) to be submitted with your entry, with a maximum of two photos. Marks to be allocated as follows: 30 marks for History, 30 marks for Conformation, 40 marks for Condition and Turnout.

### **RoR**

#### **RoR Jockey Club Novice Show Series Qualifier 2019**

Thoroughbred mare or gelding, 4years old or over, any height. Riders must be 15 years or over on the 1st January of the calendar year holding the classes. Horses should be ridden in a snaffle, pelham or simple double bridle with a plain cavasson noseband. Horses should be plaited.

To take part in this class, horses must NOT have won an ridden open class (inc SEIB/HOYS, BSHA, SHB(GB) RoR Tattersalls Show Series Qualifier, TARRA Ridden, RoR AMATEUR Ridden Show Series Qualifier or any other open class except RoR TBA Challenge Show Series classes. Unaffiliated Show wins are not taken into account. Horses **WILL** be ridden by the judge. Horses will be stripped for conformation.

**Horses may remain in RoR Jockey Club novice show series classes until they win 3 RoR Jockey Club novice show series qualifiers. They are de-noviced on their third novice win or on the day they win an open class, whichever happens first. They are still eligible to compete in the RoR Jockey Club Final at the RoR National Show that August. The first three go forward to the Final at the RoR Championships, Aintree in**

Please be aware that the show will split the class on the horse's last run in a race (NH or Flat) should the entries exceed 20. Please mark your entry form accordingly. **Competitors must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap. Racing injuries and blemishes are NOT ignored in this series.**

This class is a qualifier for the RoR OPEN In Hand Showing Series FINAL. **The first three go forward to the final at the RoR Goffs Uk National Championships at Aintree in August 2019 or 2020 for shows after 1st August 2019 to the 31st July 2020.** This class is a qualifier for the RoR OPEN In Hand Showing Series FINAL.

## **Palomino**

Palomino Wales classes are open to any exhibitor, they need not be a member of any society, this applies to unregistered palomino ponies and horses. In-hand exhibits to be shown with manes and tails free. For ridden classes plaiting is optional. Our classes will not alter the way or interfere with the rules of any show where we have a qualifier. Exhibitors that have a Palomino Wales qualifying card and are placed in the first four can ask the judge or steward to sign their card with position they finished before they leave the ring.

## **NPS Mountain and Moorland**

Affiliation Number: S28.026

These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part bred are not eligible. Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern August 2020.

The highest placed pony owned by an NPS member in each class will qualify for the final. Where this pony has already qualified, the pony standing next in line which is owned by an NPS member, and has not already qualified, receives the qualification. Qualification may go to no lower than 3rd place. Judges and /or stewards are requested to check membership cards prior to presenting the qualifying rosettes.

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship – Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rule Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show.

### **Traditional Gypsy Club Association**

**TGCA TOYS In Hand and Ridden Classes** Affiliation No 19/0308/STQ

Classes are qualifiers for the Best of Breed Finals at the Traditional Gypsy Cob Association's (TGCA) National Breed Championship Show "TOYS". Classes are open to all pure bred traditional gypsy cobs.

**Stallions** – All stallions (four years and over) in order to enter any TGCA affiliated class **MUST** have be TGCA registered, have passed TGCA evaluations and their TGCA stallion disc displayed on their bridle. Stallions and colts over the age of two, **MUST** be shown in a stallion bridle with a metal bit and chain lead as per the current TGCA rulebook.

Existing TGCA members must present their qualification card to the judge in the ring for signature. Non-members will receive a qualification card from the judge and have 21 days to join the TGCA and register their horse to validate the qualification. Please refer to [www.tgca.co.uk](http://www.tgca.co.uk) for further details including membership, horse registration and showing rules (contained within the members handbook).

**For Quest Championship – Quest for a Star Championship In hand and Ridden**

1st, 2nd and 3rd from the TGCA classes may go forward to the Quest for a Star Championship, provided they are current TGCA members and the horse is TGCA registered. Membership cards and qualification cards (specific to that exhibit) must be presented upon entry into the ring. The Champion and Reserve qualify for the Ultimate Star Championships at TOYS.

### **Shetland Ponies**

1. Classes must be confined to SPS-BSRegistered Ponies. Ponies must be named on the entry form and in the catalogue if one is produced. Society rosettes must only be given to ponies registered with the Society or eligible for registration (i.e. foals).
2. Three year old fillies with foals at foot may not be shown. All foals must be a minimum of three weeks old on the day of the Show. All entire males aged 2 years and over must display a stallion disc.
3. There must be no colts or entire males in Young Handlers classes. Children under 14 years old may not show colts (excluding foals) or entire males in In-hand classes. Children under 12 yrs old on the day of the Show may not show entire males in ridden classes. In the interest of safety hard hats must be worn by all handlers aged 14 years or under in In-hand classes. Exhibitors should not kneel but remain standing while in the Ring. Hard hats must be worn by all exhibitors, irrespective of age, in ridden classes. Ridden and driven ponies must be 4 years old or over. In Ridden Classes, if a rider falls off at any time whilst in the Ring, both pony and rider must leave the Ring, rider dismounted, and take no further part.
